

## Home learning

In a short five weeks, 10 archdioceses, 143 dioceses and 7 countries have joined the Magis Center's home learning initiative with an impact of over 33,000 students world-wide.

The home learning offerings include:

- **Teacher Webinar** covering the *7 Essential Modules* to show teachers how to teach the *Modules* online to students (Monday, May 18th @ 1:00 - 2:00 PM PT / 2:00 - 3:00 PM MT / 3:00 - 4:00 PM CT / 4:00 - 5:00 PM ET).
- **Parent Webinar** covering the *7 Essential Modules* to show parents how to teach the *Modules* to children at home (Wednesday, May 20 @ 1:00 - 2:00 PM PT / 2:00 - 3:00 PM MT / 3:00 - 4:00 PM CT / 4:00 - 5:00 PM ET).
- **7-Week Online Student Course every Monday and Tuesday** covering the *7 Essential Modules* and allowing students to take the course from home (April 6<sup>th</sup>– May 19<sup>th</sup>; classes will be held @ 10:00 - 11:00 AM PT / 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM MT / 12:00 - 1:00 PM CT / 1:00 - 2:00 PM ET). The Tuesday class is an alternative time for the same course offered on Mondays.

The online student course takes students (ages 12 and older) through the *7 Essential Modules* and is intended to help students see how science, reason, and logic support and complement our Catholic faith. The online webinars will be focused on providing an overview of the *7 Essential Modules* to Catholic educators and parents interested in using the *Modules* with students online or at home including where to find supporting resources.

Four measures have been instituted to ensure *Safe Environment* compliance:

- The course registration process will require parental consent.
- The course registration process will require “appropriate attire” for webinar participation.
- The course instructor has completed VIRTUS training and certification.
- The webinar will include a notification stating that the session is “recorded for the sake of transparency.”
